"This has come to exceed 21 MW, out of 17 planned, especially at nighttime peak hours, which here, unlike in the nation, moves at eleven o'clock at night; Hence, we implement rigorous measures in the state, such as running production processes outside of those hours.

"Thus, for example, the workers of the Combinado Cárnico have had to undertake their productions at dawn and those of the Marmol has brought forward an hour before, that is, for seven in the morning the start of their tasks in order to take advantage of the day and not interfere with the peak hours of the day. "Esteban Hernández stated that the growth in demand in pine homes "may be understandable, especially if we take into account the increase in the standard of living, with a marked index in districts such as Abel Santamaría, Micro-70 and a part of La Fe, to starting with the purchase of household appliances and air conditioning equipment, which in the last three months exceeded 5,000."It also responds to the high temperatures and to the longer stay of families in the homes, not only due to the summer stage but since April due to social isolation as part of the measures adopted to curb infections by the coronavirus."He pointed out that it is not a question of denying the benefits of modernity but of consuming only the necessary energy, because sometimes lights and equipment are left on unnecessarily; nor are alternatives applied for the efficient use of them."The increase in demand implies that plants or machines whose operation is based on diesel must enter the system, which makes electricity generation more expensive and makes it inefficient."That is why," he continued, "as part of the Save Now campaign, we are developing, together with the mass organizations, other community factors and the Union of Young Communists (UJC) dissimilar actions, such as the neighborhood debates."We created two youth detachments and they have already visited more than 17,000 houses, with the purpose of encouraging the residents to consciously save because it is the way that families can be consistent with the current situation in the country."He specified that the State is making a huge effort to ensure electricity generation for the pine farmers, for which about 80,000 liters of fuel are required, and we already know the obstacles to being able to acquire it due to the persecution of the United States.The premise? It is more than clear for both the state and residential sectors, in both there are reserves, so let's not postpone the... Save now.
