More than six thousand boys in Isla de la Juventud have contributed from March to date to territorial self-sufficiency, said Mizaida Martínez Menéndez, a member of the Municipal Committee of the Union of Young Communists (UJC). She said that in that period, the productive mobilizations were organized towards the revitalization of the organoponics, guarantors of vegetables and fresh condiments to the population, for whose tribute twice a week Urban Agriculture has saved 16,220.00 CUP in salary. Yaimet Piñero Muñoz, a third-year student from the “Martha Machado Cuní” pedagogical school specializing in music education in primary education, highlighted the activities related to the cultural care of the crops, weeding, sheeting of roads and cleaning of beds. and preschool. At the end of April I joined these calls because in the difficult moments that the municipality and the rest of the national territory were experiencing, it was up to young people to assume responsibly the mission of producing food and organizing daily life in our communities, he said exclusively to the Cuban News Agency. For his part, Martínez Menéndez specified that under strict observance of hygienic-sanitary measures due to COVID-19, those summoned planted -in different productive bases- 10.5 hectares (ha) of sweet potato, yucca, banana and pineapple, They fertilized one hectare of lemon and freed two hectares of marabou. We undertake other activities in the territory related to the Life Task (Plan of the Cuban State to Confront climate change) with the planting of coconut trees at the entrances of the Bibijagua and Paraíso beaches and the sanitation of the Las Casas River, the main tributary of the city
