



Respect for the use of the nasobuco out of the water will allow us to enjoy the beach responsibly, after so long in distance due to COVID-19, the young Alexander Delv González told the Citizen Portal. He commented that he took advantage of the proximity of Punta de Piedra to Nueva Gerona to access that coastal site on foot together with a group of friends and neighbors in order to release the logical stress that the lack of leisure due to the epidemiological situation of the country.

I enjoy the moment, it is good to see how consciously we wear the mask and order to acquire gastronomic offers, I celebrate that all of us have in some way contributed with our action to control the pandemic in the special municipality, said the university student.

Punta de Piedra, together with Paraso, El Gallego and Bibijagua are one of the riverside sites with a communication infrastructure created by the Revolution, which it is possible to reach in this summer period to enjoy the warmth of its waters and the typical vegetation of coastal ecosystems.

However, to avoid large concentrations of people, the Temporary Group for the prevention and control of the new coronavirus in Isla de la Juventud - a territory with a low prevalence of COVID-19 - prohibited the mass transportation of bathers aboard state buses or porters

private, as well as the realization of cultural and / or recreational activities.

As part of the relaxation of containment measures against the pandemic, from this July 24, locals - without neglecting biosecurity protocols - can enjoy swimming pools, restaurants and palates, available to the public at 50 percent of their installed capacities . Among the options for this summer are the excursions planned by the Flora and Fauna and Commerce companies; the use of sports facilities for physical activities and sports and gymnasiums at 50 per cent of their capacity.

Similarly, bars, state and non-state cafeterias provide on-site service, for which it is an essential requirement to comply with what is signed by the Public Health Directorate, especially respecting physical distance (two meters between tables) and maintaining the premises with natural ventilation.

In order to avoid concentrations of people, the authorities of the territory ratify the prohibition of holding public shows, popular festivals, community anniversaries, therefore the discos, cabarets, cultural areas, or the dance hall called la Mecanica will not work neither.

As the special municipality remains in the phase of limited autochthonous transmission, the Temporal Group established that all activities always conclude at 12 at night.
